Having lived abroad as a child (Zambia, Austria, Germany, Namibia, Sierra Leone) Miranda came to London to complete a degree in fine art film and video at Central St. Martin's. In 1998, she formed an arts organization called The Glue Factory which dedicated itself to promoting fine art and film and staging exhibitions in disused factories across London. She was selected as one of Screen's 'Stars of Tomorrow' in 2006.

Miranda also writes short stories which have been included in various anthologies (including 'Talking to Strangers' edited by Toby Litt) and on-line magazines.
