

## Jon Clark

Lighting Designer

Jon is a Tony and Olivier award-winning lighting designer. He has designed extensively in the West End, on Broadway, for the National Theatre, Royal Opera House, Royal Shakespeare Company and with many other companies in the UK and internationally.

Jon won the Tony Award for Best Lighting Design of a Play for The Lehman Trilogy in 2022 and in 2019 won the Olivier Award for Best Lighting Design for his work on The Inheritance. He was nominated for a 2019 Drama Desk Award in New York for Outstanding Lighting Design for his work on The Jungle. Along with the cast and creative team, Jon won an Obie Award in New York, also for The Jungle. He is the recipient of Green Room Australia Award for Best Opera Lighting Design for Krol Roger at the Sydney Opera House and won a Knight of Illumination Award for Three Days of Rain in the West End in 2009.
