Joel is a Singaporean playwright based in London. Described as one of the most exciting Singapore playwrights of his generation, his plays have received acclaim for their lyrical and incisive interrogation of his home city's politics and society. Joel was part of Theatre503's residency scheme, the 503 Five, and an associate artist with the London-based Chinese Arts Now Festival and Singapore's Checkpoint Theatre. He has an MA in Dramatic Writing from the Drama Centre, Central Saint Martins, which he pursued under a scholarship from Singapore's National Arts Council.
