Khalil Madovi is an award nominated music artist, composer, writer, actor and filmmaker. He emerged in 2012 with a hit TV series and has since embarked on a diversified career in arts and entertainment, working with the likes of Channel 4, Amazon Studios, Warner Bros. and more.

After composing for and featuring in 'Can I Live?', for Complicité and The Barbican in 2021, he went on to design for Bush Theatre's critically acclaimed 'Red Pitch', for which he received an Offie nomination. Other credits include Nouveau Riche and New Diorama Theatre's 'Brenda's Got A Baby', The Old Vic's 'This Is What The Journey Does' and Bola Agbaje's 'Gone Too Far!' with the National Youth Theatre. The BAFTA winning south London native is currently shooting his self-written and directed visual album, 'A COLD HEARTED SUMMER', which is due for release in 2025. In 2024 Khalil was nominated for a Black British Theatre Award for his Sound Design work.
