Rebekah began her career as an actress, training at the Central School of Speech and Drama where she earned a BA in Acting and an MA in Classical Theatre. She went on to tour extensively with her own theatre company, Negativequity, before moving into filmmaking.

An openly autistic filmmaker, Rebekah founded Seahorse Films with a clear mission: to develop a bold slate of projects that balance creativity and commercial appeal, while championing greater opportunities for women and disabled artists both on and off screen.

A committed advocate for underrepresented talent, Rebekah has mentored with BFI Network, served on the BAFTA short film jury, and is an alumna of Network@LFF, Edinburgh Talent Lab, BIFA Springboard, Screen Yorkshire Flex and Breaking Through the Lens. She also works extensively with young disabled actors, preparing them for careers both in front of and behind the camera.
