Profiles of Malcolm Lowry, Nadine Gordimer, Ruth P Jhabvala, Samuel Beckett, Mishima, Marcel Duchamp, Jocelyn Brooke and the bunraku Theatre of Japan, as well as an early history of photography, FROM TODAY PAINTING IS DEAD, a further photography documentary made with Susan Sontag, an impression of New York called WEST SIDE STORIES with Jonathan Miller and Patti Smith, a history of TV commercials, BUT THE CLIENT LOVED IT...WOMEN IN CAPTIVITY, the story of female prisoners of war in the Far East. Documentaries for the award-winning ARENA (BAFTA Award winner in 1982, 1983, 1984) have been LAST WALTZ IN VIENNA (1983), an account of the fortunes of a Jewish family in Austria in the 1930's, MY DINNER WITH LOUIS (1984), a profile of French film director Louis Malle, FROM AN IMMIGRANT'S NOTEBOOK (1985), an account of Karen Blixen in Africa, THE JOURNEY MAN (1986), a film on English travel writer and novelist, Norman Lewis, and a two-part documentary on Alfred Hitchcock.
