

# Tyrell Williams

Writer / Director

Tyrell Williams is an award-winning writer and director for theatre, film, and television. His first play RED PITCH, directed by Daniel Bailey, completed its sold-out run at Bush Theatre in 2022. The play transferred to the West End at Soho Place in 2024. A screen adaptation is currently in development with Fudge Park. Tyrell co-created, co-wrote, and directed the viral web series #HoodDocumentary in 2015, which has amassed over 4 million views on YouTube. Following its online acclaim, #HoodDocumentary was commissioned for BBC Three, which Tyrell directed and co-wrote. Tyrell has other original television scripts in development with Fudge Park and Paramount Studios. He is currently under commission to Eleanor Llyod Productions for an original play, ESCALATE.

Tyrell was on the BAFTA Elevate scheme in 2018 and recognized as a Broadcast Hotshot in 2016.
