Moin Hussain is a British-Pakistani writer/director who was named a Screen Star of Tomorrow in 2018. His first short, HOLY THURSDAY, was funded by Creative England and screened internationally. His second short, REAL GODS REQUIRE BLOOD (penned by Tom Benn) premiered at Cannes Semaine de la Critique 2017 and was nominated for Best Short Film at the BFI London Film Festival 2017. It screened at numerous festivals worldwide, including Sitges, Frightfest and Edinburgh. His next original short film, NAPTHA (for Foreign Material, Film 4 and Film London) screened at BFI LFF 2018 and was selected for the Cannes Semaine de la Critique 2019. Moin was accepted onto the TOP BOY mentor scheme for Cowboy Films/Netflix and shadowed director Nia DaCosta during prep, production and post. His first original feature Birchanger Green is currently in development with Escape Films and Film 4.
